Guidelines: Exhibition opportunities are available to artists with disabilities only. Please view the following guidelines and complete the application form to apply for exhibiting. Forms can be sent to VSA arts of Minnesota.

- 1) All work must be original. We cannot accept copies, kits, paint-by-number pieces, photocopies or photographs of artwork, magazine or book illustrations.
- 2) VSA arts of Minnesota works to highlight professional artists with disabilities who are actively working in their art form. It is required that work submitted has been created within the last 3-4 years.
- 3) All entrants must be a Minnesota resident.
- 4) Medium Categories:
 - a. Paintings (oil, acrylics, watercolor, etc.)
 - b. Works on paper (pencil, ink, marker, pastel, crayon, charcoal (must be fixed), graphic design, printmaking, etc.)
 - c. Photography (black & white, color)
 - d. Tapestries (fiber art, weaving (2 dimensional))
- 5) All artwork must be ready to hang (framed or hard board mounted) with picture wire and I.D. label placed on the back.
- 6) The installation of the exhibition is at the discretion and responsibility of the organizers.
- 7) Out of respect for our public locations which host the exhibitions, artwork featuring frontal nudity can not be accepted.
- 8) If accepted to exhibit, artwork needs to be accompanied by an artist statement, along with a list of submitted work including: titles, dimensions, medium and pricing.
